

Occupy Madison Inc. Appeal Form

Any member of Occupy Madison, Inc. has the right to appeal any decision of the Board of Directors. The appeal must be submitted to a Board member no later than 10 days after the decision has been made or written in the minutes and then distributed to the members. However, submitting an appeal will not delay the implementation of the action decided by the Board. If you are dissatisfied with the outcome of your appeal you may bring your appeal to the General Membership at the next scheduled meeting or you may call for a special General Membership meeting in agreement with sections VI 2, 4, 5 of the Occupy Madison, Inc. bylaws. VI. Membership Meetings

1. Regular membership meetings shall be held monthly.
- *2. Special membership meetings may be held at any time when called for by the President, a majority of Board members or 10% of the membership.
3. Agendas shall be provided at least 3 days in advance when possible.
- *4. Quorum at a membership meeting shall be (7) people present and voting. Passage of a motion requires a simple majority unless one or more members call for a major decision which requires a $\frac{3}{4}$ vote by the membership.
- *5. Major decision may include, but are not limited to decisions about membership, Board composition, passing the budget or budget amendments or other items where one or more members calls for it to be a major decision vote.
