

Resident Participation Policy

1. All residents are required to attend one Occupy Madison Inc (OMI) level meeting in a week.
2. All residents are required to attend one Village level meeting a week.
3. All residents are required to put in an average of 10 hours of Sweat Equity a week over a month period.
4. All residents are required to do half an hour of chores a week.
5. Working people can make monetary or supply donations instead of or as well as chores.
6. Process of accountability:
 - a. After reviewing the residents progress for the week an incident report will be filed if the above requirements are not met.
 - b. Then you will be asked to take a reflection time of 4 days for the first offense, 7 for the second and doubling thereafter, during which time you will not be allowed on Occupy Madison properties.
 - c. The resident will have 24 hours to gather the things they will need before their reflection time starts. After the reflection time has ended the resident returns to the Village and a fresh slate is started, meaning by returning to the Village the resident has recommitted to the organization and the community that they live in and the process starts again. Note: Any sweat equity hours previously earned will be retained.
